PROTECT YOURSELF AND YOUR FAMILY—CALL JULIE BEFORE YOU DIG!!

In observance of National Safe Digging Month in April, JULIE recently announced results from a national survey conducted by the Common Ground Alliance. **Nearly 40 percent of homeowners** who plan to dig this year for projects like planting a tree or shrub, installing a fence or mailbox, or building a deck, pond or patio and other DIY projects will **put themselves, their families and their communities at risk by not submitting a locate request** at least two business days beforehand.

If a contractor has been hired, confirm that the contractor notified JULIE. Do not allow work to begin if the underground utility lines are not marked. A contractor should never tell you that there is no need to contact JULIE for a digging project.

Confirm that all lines have been marked and consider moving the location of your project if it is near utility line markings. Call 811 or 800-892-0123 before you dig! *(excerpted from JULIE, INC)*
